- Declared its commitment to the CAC on 1 September 2011
- Received its first CAC Certification on 22 April 2016
- Renewed its CAC Certification for the first time on 18 October 2019
- Renewed its CAC Certification for the second time on 30 September 2022
- Renewed its CAC Certification for the third time on 30 September 2025

In addition, CENTEL has been certified as a “**CAC Change Agent**” at the highest level (3 stars) since 2024 and successfully renewed this status in 2025. This recognition serves as strong evidence of the Company’s commitment to encouraging and supporting its subsidiaries, business partners, and stakeholders to operate with good corporate governance and to actively join the fight against corruption.
